GOALS

INTRODUCTION

These days, corruption is a problem that practically every nation on the planet faces. One of the subjects that transnational crime has addressed extensively on a global scale in recent years is corruption.

Several international legal rules, among which are the following, express the priority legal framework for thwarting corruption:

- UN Convention Against Corruption, adopted on 31 October 2003;
- UN Convention Against Transnational Organized Crime adopted on November 15, 2000, The university has its own administrative department and power to carry out the laws and policies in an open and effective manner.
- Council of Europe Convention on criminal liability for corruption, 27 January 1999;
- The civil legal responsibility for corruption conventions of November 4, 1999, etc.

The National University of Uzbekistan works to uphold its commitment to eliminating all forms of crime, including bribery and corruption. The university is dedicated to abiding by all laws, policies, and guidelines established by the Republic of Uzbekistan and comply with the decrees: [“On The Fight Against Corruption”](#), [On Additional Measures To Further Improve The Activities Of The Anti-corruption Agency Of The Republic Of Uzbekistan](#), [“On The Judicial Practice Of Bribery Cases”](#), [“On The Establishment Of The Directorate For The Fight Against Bribery, Theft And Other Abuses In The Field Of Foreign Economic Activity In The Structure Of The Prosecutor's Office Of The Republic Of Uzbekistan”](#), Our employees, instructors, and students are subject to Uzbekistan's laws of governance. The goal of these rules and regulations is to establish a transparent, clean, effective, and high-quality government (campus). The university has its own [administrative department](#) and power to carry out the laws and policies in an open and effective manner.

PRINCIPLES

The [Anti-Corruption Department](#) of the Compliance Control system carries out:

- monitors compliance with laws and regulations related to the fight against corruption at the university, as well as decisions and orders of the Ministry;
- develops measures and work plans aimed at preventing corruption offenses, ensures their full, high-quality and timely implementation, studies the status of implementation of planned measures, prepares information on their results;
- implements the project "Sphere without corruption" at the university;
- develops and submits for approval to the rector drafts of internal documents aimed at implementing anti-corruption measures at the university;
- develops proposals to eliminate corruption norms identified in internal documents of the university;
- assesses corruption risks at the university and develops action plans to reduce them;
- considers incoming appeals and anonymous reports about corruption risks and offenses in the actions of the faculty, management, technical, service and educational support staff of the university and takes measures in accordance with the established procedure;
- maintains a register of official investigations of corruption in the university;
- participates in the analysis of conflicts of interest and verification of the reliability of counterparties in public procurement;
- monitors conflicts of interest between university staff and makes appropriate proposals;
- organizes regular preventive conversations between the faculty, management, technical, maintenance, teaching and support staff of the university;
- conducts surveys of faculty, management, technical, service, teaching and support staff, students (undergraduates, doctoral students, independent researchers) and the public in order to identify corruption situations in the university's activities;

PRINCIPLES

- systematically assesses the results and impact of anti-corruption measures based on surveys, social and other studies, and also uses the results of the assessment in determining further measures;
- organizes conferences, meetings, seminars, competitions aimed at combating corruption among the teaching staff, students;
- evaluates the effectiveness of measures taken in the field of combating corruption at the university;
- studies the conditions and causes of corruption offenses at the university, and also develops proposals for their elimination;
- provides regular updating of information in the section “Anti-corruption” on the official website of the University;
- quarterly and, as necessary, reports to the rector on the work done to combat corruption and the corruption situation at the university) and the Department for Control and Combating Corruption of the Ministry of Higher and Secondary Special Education;
- Establishes effective cooperation in the field of anti-corruption with the Department for Control and Anti-Corruption of the Ministry of Higher and Secondary Special Education and other state bodies and organizations engaged in anti-corruption activities, with parents;
- supervises the activities of the Academic Lyceum at the University on combating corruption;
- monitors anti-corruption work at the university, implements analytical materials in the management, as well as in the Ministry.
