# CLEAR MORAL VALUES AT ALL LEVELS OF OUR UNIVERSITY

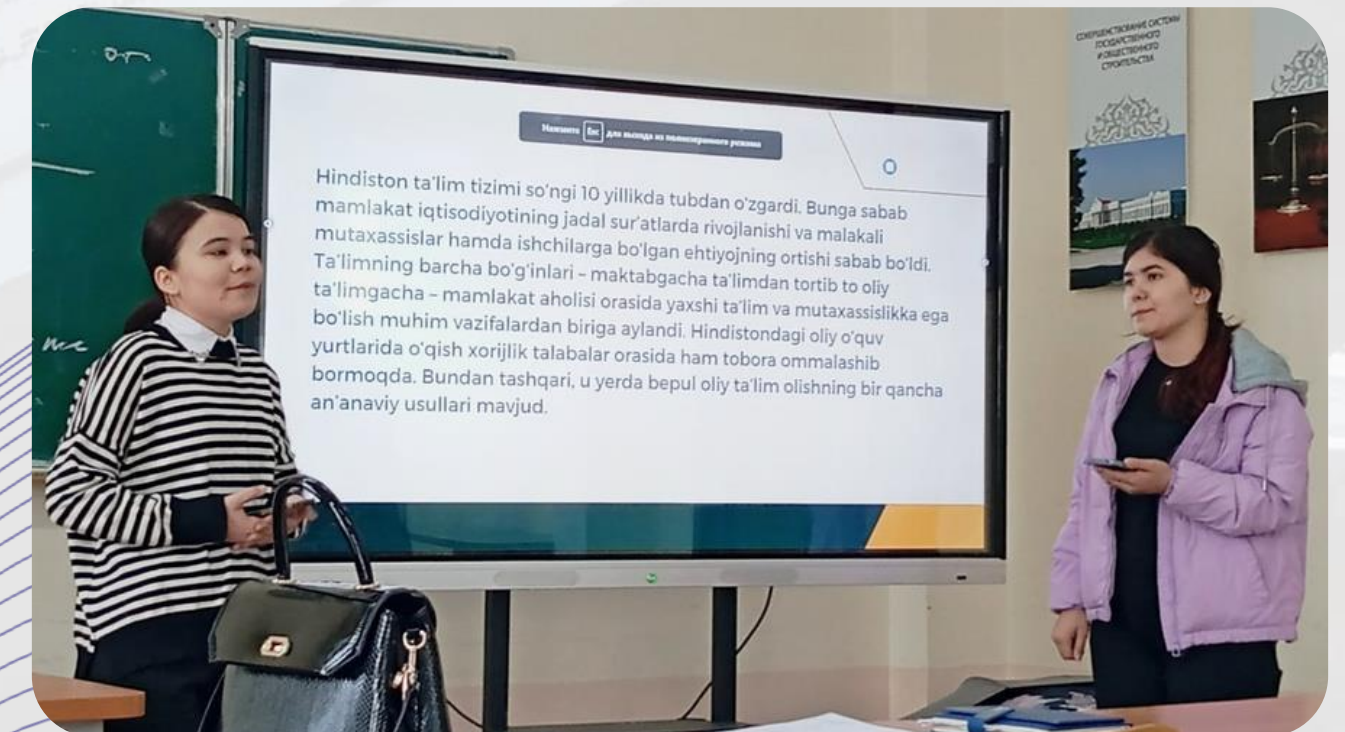


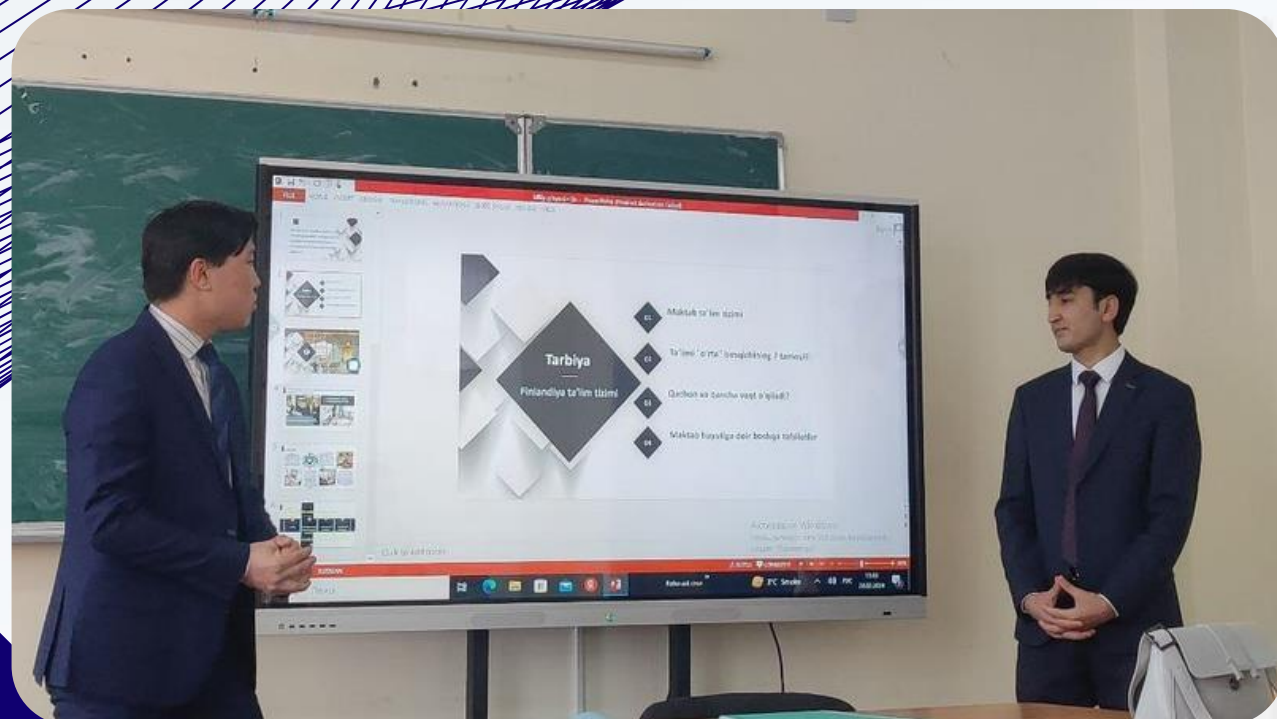

Students of the Faculty of Social Sciences of the National University of Uzbekistan exchange ideas about the rules of etiquette and the concepts of mutual respect, fairness, gentleness and equality among students through round tables and discussion evenings, protests arise among students due to the violation of various national values. Eliminate the conditions that lead to this , to build an environment in student residences based on the concepts of mutual respect.

National University of Uzbekistan, lately spreading the concepts of general etiquette and applying the concepts of fairness and gentleness to inculcate these concepts in the minds of students in winter, the teachers of our university organize talks and various workshops on educating students in the spirit of justice during information hours.

Through engaging presentations and open discussions, students were encouraged to share their own experiences and concerns in a supportive and non-judgmental environment.

University officials dealing with women's issues, chairmen of the women's council of faculties, female professors and teachers, female students participated in it and exchanged opinions on the topic.





It is worth noting that the adviser to the rector on women's issues of the National University of Uzbekistan Rustamova Rano parpievna in her report said: "The whole point is that discipline begins with education." The scientific seminar discussed the work carried out in the modern globalizing world in connection with the need for adult education and training, the development of professional knowledge and skills, support for the education of women and men, common moral values in the educational process, equality in the educational process, and raising public awareness of the amenities created in the field of education.
